
# Article 1. What are Scripture Sticky Notes?

Sticky Notes are fantastic to use in your scriptures. When you study there just isn't enough room in the margins to make all the notes you'd like. Using Sticky Notes gives you additional space to add comments, references, quotes, or whatever you want, to your scriptures. And because they are in color, they quickly draw your attention. There are 2 things to notice in the pictures above.


1) The Sticky Note on the left is hand written and only has the scripture verse and circled letter at the top.

2) The orange Sticky Note on the right is printed and has the latest information at the top which coordinates with the entire ScriptureKIT marking system.

The Sticky Note on the left is how we started many years ago and is still acceptable; however, the Sticky Note on the right is more advanced and fits in with our complete ScriptureKIT study system. We will explain this Sticky Note later.

You will also notice the pictures below show how a scripture page looks when it has several Sticky Notes on it. Keep reading to see how to organize your Sticky Notes on a page. When you get this many it can hinder your view of the page.







The following explains the different parts of a Sticky Note. This Sticky Note has been printed, but you can just write on one.



**B** Scripture. Next to the letter in the circle is the scripture reference for the Sticky Note. This is so you can see what the Sticky Note refers to and also handy if a Sticky Note becomes misplaced or falls out of your scriptures.



Title. A title isn't necessary, but can be a quick reminder of what's on the Sticky Note.

**IP# & MS#'s, eF#, Date.** These numbers are optional. The IP and MS numbers come from ScriptureKIT Book 1 Information Pages (IP) & ScriptureKIT Book 2 Cross Referencing System (MS). The ScriptureKIT books contain insightful information and a unique cross-referencing system for the entire LDS Standard Works. eF#s reference Bruce Barton's *ez*FIND!- a computerized database for everything you own. The date will let you know when you added this Sticky Note.

**Body.** This is your content (explanation, personal thoughts, quotes, stories, etc).

### Here are 3 primary ways to use Sticky Notes.

A Luke 10:17-20

1. To <u>EXPLAIN</u> the words, meanings or people in a scripture verse(s). (Example 1)

**3**. As <u>QUOTES</u> from other people about a scripture verse(s). (Example 3)

**Scorpions & Snakes** A scorpion represents something which can hurt us. Symbolically that "something" represents evil. Simply stepping on a scorpion will not kill it! Scorpions have the ability to flatten their bodies to the approximate thickness of a credit card and live to bite again. So how do you kill a scorpion? By using the full force of your body, press and twist to squish it and break its body apart. The message here is it's not just the power (priesthood) to overcome your enemy which is needed, but how you use it. With a scorpion, you kill it one way, with a snake, another way. Satan doesn't just work in one way with one "thing" to get us. We must know our enemy and the way to kill it-or it will kill us! © 2012 Bruce Barton www.brucebarton.com

For instance: Nephi and his brethren were seeking to obtain the brass plates from Laban. Their lives were in peril. Yet Nephi swore this oath: 1 Ne. 3:15. Thus Nephi made God his partner. If he failed to get the plates, it meant God had failed. And because God does not fail, it was incumbent upon Nephi to get the plates or lay down his life in the attempt.

"One of the most solemn oaths ever given to man is found in these words of the Lord relative to Joseph Smith and the Book of Mormon. 'He [meaning Joseph Smith] has translated the book, even that part which I have commanded him,' saith the Lord, 'and as your Lord and your God liveth it is true.' (D&C 17:6.) <u>This is God's testimony of the Book of Mormon.</u> In it Deity himself has laid his godhood on the line. Either the book is true or God ceases to be God." [Elder Bruce R. McConkie; Conference Report, April 1982; p.49-50]
