Choose to Read (CTR) the Scriptures, the #3

Joseph Smith said, "I have a key by which I understand the scriptures. I enquire, what was the question which drew out the answer, or caused Jesus to utter the parable?... To ascertain its meaning, we must dig up the root and ascertain what it was that drew the saying out of Jesus." [HC, 5:261]



Do you think Joseph Smith ever asked "Why" while reading the scriptures? Yes, his quote above shows that he did. But why did he ask why?—because he wanted to know MORE. Do you want to know more? Then follow Joseph's example and ask why when reading your scriptures. For instance:

- WHY were there 3 gifts for Jesus from the Wise Men from the East and not 1 or 2 or 5 or more? Certainly these Magi could afford more. (Mt. 2:11)
- WHY did Satan tempt Jesus 3 times in a row in 3 different ways? Why not several more times and ways to wear him down? (Mt. 4:3-9)
- WHY did the Savior's ministry last 3 years? Wouldn't it have been great to have it last five years or longer? (DC 138:25)
- WHY would the Savior pray 3 times in the Garden of Gethsemane? Wasn't once enough? Was it because the apostles were sleeping? (Mt. 6:39-49)
- WHY was Jesus Christ resurrected after 3 days? Wouldn't it have been more im pressive after a month? (Mosiah 3:10)
- WHY did Jesus ask Peter 3 times if he loved Him? Wasn't Peter listening? And why did the Savior's response to Peter change? (Jn. 21:15-17)

These questions involve the number three. "3" is a fascinating number. Its use in the world describes such things as a triangle; the dimensions of a cube—length, width, height; the divisions of time—past, present, and future; and even more. But what does the number three have to do with scripture? As used in scripture, "three" is usually symbolic of **God's covenants**, will, purpose, influence, involvement and satisfaction. It also suggests full, complete, and sufficient (e.g., the 3 members of the Godhead—Elohim (God the Father), Jesus Christ (God the Son), and the Holy Ghost (13AF1); 3 attributes of a God—Omnipotent, Omniscient, and Omnipresent; and the 3 Degrees of Glory—Telestial, Terrestrial, and Celestial (DC 76)).

Jesus used numbers and other items as symbols such as names, food, body parts, colors, plants, the four elements of earth, animals, places and titles to enrich the lives of His <u>believers</u>. Remember, Christ used parables to disguise the truth from those who would not appreciate it, but also to explain truth to those who sought it by **pondering** about what he said. When you discover the use of "3" in the scriptures, a deeper meaning opens up to you—<u>if</u> you **think** about it.

When I find instances where "three" things occur, I ask myself why this would be? Doing so is fun, interesting and enlightening. Why don't YOU try it in your reading? At first you will catch the obvious places where the words "three" or "third" or "thrice" are in the verse, like "...and the *third* day he shall rise again." (Mt. 20:19) But then you will begin to pick up on verses where the number three is not specifically mentioned. For example, "...I am the *way*, the *truth*, and the *life*..." (Jn. 14:6) and "...gold, and *frankincense* and *myrrh*..." (Mt. 2:11) And, like a parable, the final level of difficulty gets really interesting. For example, find the use of three spread out over several scripture verses. Here's one: Jesus raised 3 people from the dead. (Mk. 5:22-24, 35-43; Lk. 7:11-17; Jn. 11:1-46) Looking for "3's" is one way to "enquire" further into the scriptures and to understand them better as Joseph Smith suggested.

Jesus Christ invited all to **search and find** the truth: "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you." (Mt. 7:6-7) See how many times the use of **three** jumps out at you when you read the scriptures. Each time ask **why** and enquire further. You WILL be surprised!
